



Karalundi exists for the academic and spiritual education of the Aboriginal people of Western Australia. We are a school, which is registered to take students from K-12. The dorm staff run activities and programs for students when they are not in school to keep them active and engaged. We welcome applications from all interested people. However, it is important for you to understand the culture of the school before filling in the application forms. Please read the following information carefully.

Things you need to know before applying for enrolment

- Karalundi is a Christian community established to house and teach children in a Christian environment. Students are expected to participate in worship activities every day in the dormitories and attend the weekly church services. They will be expected to behave in a way which is consistent with Christian values and morals.
- Karalundi is an isolated community. It is 55km from the nearest town, Meekatharra. There are very limited opportunities for students to go to town and there is very little to do when they are in town.
- Students are expected to attend school all day every day. There are no other options.
- Karalundi is a dry community. **No** drugs of any sort are allowed here. This includes alcohol and cigarettes. Students who have addictions of any sort should make sure they are free of the addiction before applying for enrolment.
- Students living in the dormitory will be expected to follow all instructions. This means getting up on time, doing assigned duties, keeping their room clean and tidy, returning to the dorm when requested and staying within the boundaries.
- Mobile phones and other electronic devices will be handed in to dormitory staff on arrival and these will be returned to the students at designated times.
- Students must want to be here, and be willing to focus on their schooling. Students who are sent here against their will, seldom do well.
